

Merriest Wishes Popper



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Supplies:

- **Stamps:** 143520 Merriest Wishes Clear Mount Bundle, 143519 Wood Mount Bundle
- **Paper :**
 - 120953 Crumb Cake (scrap)
 - 121045 Basic Black (scrap)
 - 141628 This Christmas Specialty Designer Series Paper (4-1/2 x 6")
- **Ink :** 126975 Crumb Cake, 101406 Jet Black StazOn
- **Other :** 133774 Envelope Punch Board, 122334 Simply Scored Scoring Tool, Big Shot, 119860 1-3/8" Circle Punch, 104199 Linen Thread, 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals, candy or another small gift of choice to enclose in the popper

Instructions:

1. Run the piece of black scrap through the Big Shot Machine with the Merry Tags Framelit Die that features the decorative edges as shown.
2. Stamp the falling dots onto the piece of Crumb Cake scrap. Stamp Merriest Wishes with StazOn over the top of the falling dots and punch out with the 1-3/8" Circle Punch as shown. Secure to the black die cut with a dimensional. Set aside.
3. Score the snowflake paper on the short side at 1", 2", 3" and 4". Fold all the score lines and use Fast Fuse on the 1/2" flap to secure into a square tube shape for the body of the popper.
4. With the tube shape flattened out, punch at the one inch mark on your Envelope Punch Board. Do this on all the sides that you can to create your popper fold-ins, then flip the tube around and repeat.
5. Tie Linen Thread onto your tag. Then tie the Linen Thread around the fold-ins on each side of the popper. Add the tag before you tie off one of the end bows. It will be easy to open up the popper when you want to get the prize out if the ends are tied into bows.
