

# Christmas Pines Season of Joy Card



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## Supplies:

- **Stamps:** 142049 Christmas Pines Photopolymer Stamp Set -OR- **Save 10% and get the bundle:** 143496 Christmas Pines Photopolymer Bundle
- **Paper:**
  - 140272 Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Thick Cardstock (8 1/2" x 5 1/2")
  - 141415 Emerald Envy 8-1/2" X 11" Cardstock (4" x 5 1/4")
  - 100730 Whisper White 8-1/2" X 11" Card Stock (3 1/2" x 5" and 2" x 4")
- **Ink:** 126966 Cherry Cobbler Classic Stampin' Pad, 141396 Emerald Envy Classic Stampin' Pad, 126975 Crumb Cake Classic Stampin' Pad, 126979 Chocolate Chip Classic Stampin' Pad
- **Other:** 141989 3/8" Ribbon Silky Taffeta Combo Pack, 138281 Lots Of Labels Framelits Dies, 141831 Pine Bough Textured Impressions Embossing Folder, 139665 Perfect Pines Framelits Dies, 143263 Big Shot, 104332 SNAIL Adhesive, 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals, 103683 Glue Dots, 126889 Stampin' Trimmer

## Instructions:

1. Score and fold the 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" Whisper White cardstock in half at 4 1/4" to form the card base.
2. Emboss the Emerald Envy cardstock with the Pine Bough Embossing Folder and adhere to the front of the card.
3. Die cut the Whisper White cardstock with the Lots of Label Framelits.
4. Stamp the pine branch in Emerald Envy ink on one side of the die cut label. Stamp the sentiment in Cherry Cobbler ink below the branch.
5. Stamp the pine cone images in Crumb Cake and Chocolate Chip ink pads. Color over the two-step stamped image with Gold Wink of Stella. Die cut using the Perfect Pines framelits.
6. Use glue dots to attach the pinecones to the label under the pine branch.
7. Tie a bow with the Cherry Cobbler Silky Taffeta Ribbon and attach to the label about the pinecones.
8. Attach the label to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
