

Peaceful Poinsettia Tea Bag Envelope

Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Peaceful Poinsettia bundle (WM 149964, CM 149962), Buffalo Check (WM 147797, CM 147794)
- **Paper:** 121045 Basic Black card stock 3-1/4" x 3-1/2" scored at 1-3/4"
 - o 100730 Whisper White card stock 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- **Ink:** 132708 Tuxedo Black Memento pad, 144597 Old Olive Stampin' Blends Combo Pack, 147935 Real Red Stampin' Blends Combo Pack
- **Other:** 143263 Big Shot, 145829 Whisper White 3" x 3" envelopes, 146886 Vegas Gold Shimmer Paint, 146350 1/8" Black Cord, 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals, 104332 SNAIL Permanent Adhesive, 110755 Multipurpose Liquid Glue

Instructions:

1. Seal the 3' x 3" envelope. Stamp the envelope front and back with the Buffalo Check stamp inked with Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
2. Trim off the top of the envelope just enough to open it, creating a pouch.
3. Apply Multipurpose Glue to half of the Basic Black card stock. Line the scored edge of the Basic Black card stock to the top of the envelope and secure down the side with the glue to the back of the envelope.
4. Stamp the poinsettia on Whisper White card stock in Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color the image using Stampin' Blends. Use a cotton swap or paintbrush and apply Vegas Gold Shimmer Paint to the poinsettia center and the berries. Set aside to dry.
5. Wrap the Black cord around the Basic Black card stock and tie a bow on the front flap. Adhere the poinsettia to the front flap with Stampin' Dimensionals. Use dimensionals to also secure the Black cord to the flap.
