

# Frosted Floral Pocket card



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## Supplies:

- **Stamps:** First Frost (148417w or 148420c), or save 10% with the First Frost Bundle (149942w, 149943c)
- **Paper:**
  - 100867 Night of Navy cardstock (5 1/2" X 4 1/4" card base & 3 3/4" X 5" for inside layer")
  - 100730 Whisper White cardstock (3 1/2" X 4 3/4")
  - 147800 Frosted Floral Specialty Designer Paper (4" X 10 1/2" scored at 5 1/4" & 9 1/4")
  - 132178 Silver Foil paper (scrap for die-cut)
- **Ink:**
  - 147110 Night of Navy
  - 147104 Pear Pizzazz
- **Other:** 143263 Big Shot, 147895 Frosted Bouquet Framelits Dies, 147801 Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets, 143715 Pretty Label punch, 119850 1 3/4" Circle punch, 146336 Night of Navy medium Baker's Twine, 141337 Sponge Daubers, 104332 SNAIL Permanent Adhesive, 144108 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals,

## Instructions:

1. Fold the Designer paper into a pocket with a flap in front. Wrap the Twine around this and tie it into a bow. Adhere this piece to the large Navy card stock.
2. Punch out a 1 3/4" Navy circle punch. Adhere to the front of the fold area under the twine.
3. Ink your greeting in Navy ink and stamp on a scrap of White card stock. Punch out with the Pretty Label punch. Sponge the edge with Pear Pizzazz ink.
4. Ink the long stem image in Pear Pizzazz ink, stamp off once and stamp a few times on the side of the greeting punched piece. Adhere with dimensionals. Add two Epoxy droplets to the edges.
5. Cut out a Silver die-cut under the edge of the punched pieces.
6. Ink the floral image in Navy ink, stamp off once before stamping on the upper edge of your White inside layer. Do this twice. Adhere to the Navy pocket layer.
