

Frosted Floral Treat Pouch

Supplies:

- **Stamps:** First Frost (148417w or 148420c) **2018 Holiday Catalog**, or save 10% with the First Frost Bundle (149942w, 149943c)
- **Paper:**
 - 100867 Night of Navy cardstock (3/4" X 3" for front flap and a scrap for die-cut frame)
 - 100730 Whisper White cardstock (scrap for greeting layer)
 - 147800 Frosted Floral Specialty Designer Paper (3" X 12" scored at 4 3/4", 6" & 10 3/4")
- **Ink:**
 - 147110 Night of Navy
 - 147104 Pear Pizzazz
- **Other:** 143263 Big Shot, 147895 Frosted Bouquet Framelits Dies, 147801 Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets, 146336 Night of Navy medium Baker's Twine, 141337 Sponge Daubers, 141704 3" X 6" Gusseted Cellophane Bags, 104332 SNAIL Permanent Adhesive, 144108 138995 Tear & Tape, 103683 Mini Glue dots

Instructions:

1. Fold the Frosted Floral designer paper on the score lines. Add a Navy strip to the inside top flap.
2. Trim 3/4" off the top edge of the Cellophane bag. Adhere to the bottom of the bag with Tear & Tape so the bottom lays flat. You can add a bit of Tear & Tape to the back of the bag but it isn't necessary.
3. Die-cut a set of Navy leaves and a large Navy frame from the Frosted Bouquet framelit dies.
4. Ink your greeting in Night of Navy ink and stamp on a scrap of White card stock. Die-cut with the smaller frame in the set of Framelit dies. Ink the tip of the long leaves image in Pear Pizzazz ink and stamp off once then stamp on the lower left corner. Sponge the edge with Pear Pizzazz ink.
5. Add a clear Epoxy Droplet to the corner. Adhere together with dimensionals. Add the leaves to the back and a Navy twine bow to the front with a mini glue dot.
6. Add the greeting layer using Tear & Tape to just the bottom half of this piece. The top flap tucks under this piece to hold it closed.
7. Fill with treats!
