

# Spider Trinket Earrings



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## Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Cauldron Bubble (147713w or 147710c) or bundle with Cauldron Framelits Dies & save 10% (149930w or 149931c)
- **Paper:**
  - 147531 Toil & Trouble Designer Series Paper (wrap = 2" x 5-1/2" score at 1-1/2", 3-3/4" & 4" and piece for cauldron)
  - 146987 Gorgeous Grape (2-1/4" x 1-3/4" for earring holder)
  - 105117 Pumpkin Pie (belly band = 3/4" x 5" score at 1-1/4", 1-3/8", 3-1/2" x 3-5/8")
  - 146986 Highland Heather (scrap for 3/4" Circle Punch)
  - 100730 Whisper White (scrap for die cut cauldron)
- **Ink:** 132708 Tuxedo Black Memento Ink
- **Other:** 143263 Big Shot, 139684 Precision Base Plate, 144107 Pick Your Tool (piercing tool), 147896 Spider Trinkets, 119873 3/4" Circle Punch, 134365 1/8" Handheld Circle Punch, 103683 Glue Dots & 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals.
- **Non-Stampin' Up!:** ear wires (found at Walmart), household tape
- **Optional:** 147898 Black Foil, 144106 Multipurpose Adhesive Sheets

## Instructions:

1. **Create wrap/earring holder:** Use Pick Your Tool (piercing tool) to poke two tiny holes in earring holder piece.
2. Remove jump rings from Spider Trinkets, loop onto ear wires & pinch "close". Thread through holes and secure on back with tape. Use glue dots on bottom backside to adhere to "center section" of the folded DSP wrap (single score line is the bottom). Fold bottom up, top down.
3. **Create belly band:** Add two glue dots on one end of folded Pumpkin Pie strip. Wrap around closed wrap (not too tight). Adhere ends together in the front.
4. Die cut two cauldrons (DSP & Whisper White), adhere together.
5. Stamp greeting on scrap of Highland Heather. Cut with 3/4" Circle Punch. Cut tag hole with 1/8" handheld circle punch. Adhere to cauldron with Stampin' Dimensional (as shown)
6. Wrap twine (14") around belly band (while it's on the wrap) - leave both ends loose on the left. Place two Stampin' Dimensionals in the center of wrap, over twine, then attach cauldron/tag. Thread top twine end through tag hole. Tie ends together in a bow.
7. Belly band should slide off and on for easy access to the earrings
