Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS – Snow Is Glistening (149742 Photopolymer)
- PAPER – Crumb Cake (120953), Early Espresso (119686)
- INK – Crumb Cake (147116), Early Espresso (147114), Versamark (102283)
- OTHER – Big Shot (143263), Swirls & Curly Textured Embossing Folder (147923), 1-1/4" Circle Punch (119861), 1-12" Circle Punch (138299), Embossing Buddy (1030830), White Stampin' Emboss Powder (109132), Heat Tool (129053), Sponge Daubers (133773), Snowflake Trinkets (149620), Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Crumb Cake 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4", 4-7/8" x 3-5/8", scrap
- Early Espresso 5" x 3-3/4", scrap

Instructions:

- Emboss the Crumb Cake card base front with the Swirls & Curly Textured Embossing Folder.
- Rub Embossing Buddy over the Crumb Cake layer. Stamp the tree and snowflake images with Versamark. Apply White Stampin' Emboss Powder over the images and melt with Heat Tool.
- With a Sponge Dauber apply Crumb Cake ink to the tree image and wipe off excess with paper towel.

- Stamp tree trunk image at base of tree in Early Espresso Ink.
- Adhere the Crumb Cake layer to the Early Espresso layer. Then adhere that layer to the Crumb Cake card base.
- Stamp the sentiment on a piece of Crumb Cake scrap with Early Espresso ink. Punch out with 1-1/4" Circle Punch. Punch circle from Early Espresso scrap using the 1-1/2" Circle Punch. Adhere the two circles and apply with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Adhere the Snowflake Trinket at top of tree with a Mini Glue Dot.
- Apply randomly Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets on the snowflakes of the embossed tree.
- Enjoy!
