Cutting & Scoring:

- Pool Party 9 1/4" x 5 1/2", 2 7/8" square, 2 5/8" square, 2 3/8" square, 2 1/8 square (snowflake die)
- Basic White 2 3/4" square, 2 1/2" square, 2 1/4" square, 2" x 5 3/8" (back) & scrap
- Specialty Vellum 7/8" x 5 3/8", 1 3/8" x 5 3/8" & 2" x 5 3/8"

Instructions:

- Score large Pool Party card base on the long side at 1", 2", 3 1/2", 5" & 7 1/8". Fold all score lines and burnish. Adhere Snowflake Vellum strips to each step of card base.
- Stamp snowflakes with Pool Party Ink on Basic White squares, small sentiment on Basic White scrap and stamp a few snowflakes and large sentiment on 2" x 5 3/8" Basic White layer. Die cut LET IT SNOW with small label die.
- Adhere 2" by 5 3/8" Basic White panel to back of card base.
- Adhere Basic White squares to Pool Party squares and attach to card base as shown.

- Die cut 2 1/8" square with snowflake die and add to Basic White layer on front diamond.
 Add Mini Stampin' Dimensionals to sentiment banner and adhere to front square.
 Wrap front step with White 3/8" Glittered Organdy Ribbon and tie in know.
 Embellish with Iridescent Rhinestone Basic Jewels.
