

## Bewitching Halloween Ensemble



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### Stampin' Up! Supplies for Card:

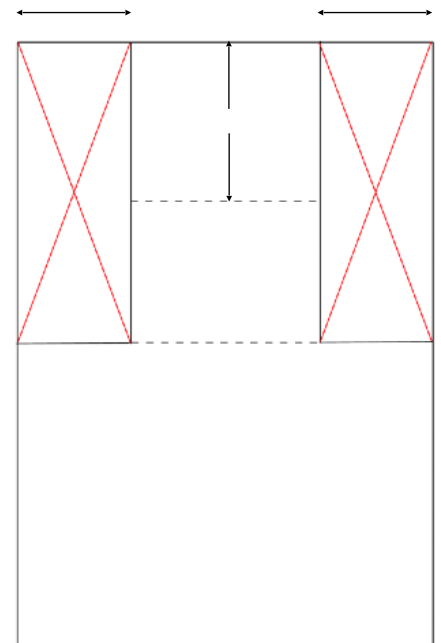
- STAMPS – Bewitching, (159855), Scary Cute (159850), Bundle & SAVE with Witch Hat Builder Punch (159856)
- PAPER – Basic White (159276), Basic Black (121045), Black & White Designs 12"x12" Designer Series Paper (159861)
- INK – Memento Black (132708), Gorgeous Grape (147099), Blends: Highland Heather (154887), Granny Apple Green (154885), VersaMark Pad (102283)
- OTHER – Stylish Shapes Dies (159183), Glitter Washi Four Pack (159973), Witch Hat Builder Punch (159856), Wink of Stella (141897), Heat Tool (129053), Basics Embossing Powders (155554), Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Seal+ (149699), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (119755), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430)

## Cutting & Scoring:

- Basic Black – 8 ½" x 5 ½" scored in half on long side, scraps
- Whisper White – 2 1/8" x 3 3/8", 2 3/8" x 2 ½", scraps
- Pumpkin Pie - scraps
- Gingham Cottage DSP – 5 ¼" x 4 ½"
- Black & White Designs DSP – 4" x 1 ¼" (x2)

## Instructions for Card:

- Referencing the diagram in second photo, trim/cut the Basic Black card base as follows:
  - Using Paper Trimmer, cut from the top edge and 1 ½" from left and right sides to the center score line on card base. The card should look like the diagram after it is cut (the pieces with the red X's should be cut off—SAVE these pieces).
  - Score the remaining top piece 2 ¼" down from top as shown in diagram—this is going to form the easel part.
  - Fold on the score line you just made (mountain fold).
- Die cut Pumpkin Pie scallop using Scalloped Rectangle Die (3 ¾" x 2 ½").
- Adhere to front of easel - be sure to only adhere underneath the score line.
- Stamp witch feet on 3 3/8" x 2 1/8" Basic White cardstock using Memento Black Ink.
- Color using Dark Highland Heather and Dark Granny Apple Green Blends.
- Add Wink of Stella to buckle.
- Stamp witch hat on Pumpkin Pie cardstock using Memento Black ink.
- Punch out and adhere to white cardstock piece, above witch feet, using Dimensionals.
- Add 2 strips of orange Washi Tape to scrap white paper so they are next to each other vertically.
- Punch this out using just the band part of the Witch Hat Builder Punch.
- Adhere Washi Tape band to witch hat.
- Stamp spider on white cardstock using Memento Black ink.
- Stamp "boo" sentiment on white cardstock using Gorgeous Grape ink.
- Adhere white cardstock to Pumpkin Pie cardstock.





- Stamp sentiment on scrap black cardstock using VersMark ink.
- Sprinkle with white embossing powder.
- Emboss using Heat Tool .
- Die cut sentiment using banner shape from Stylish Shapes Dies and adhere to card using Dimensionals.
- Adhere 2 3/8" x 2 1/2" white cardstock to inside of card behind the easel part of card.

- STAMPS – Bewitching, (159855), Scary Cute (159850), Bundle & SAVE with Witch Hat Builder Punch (159856)
- PAPER – Basic White (159276), Gingham Cottage (159651)
- INK – Memento Black (132708), Brights Stampin' Write Markers (147157), Blends: Pumpkin Pie (154897)
- OTHER –Mini Pocket Envelope Die (159167), Witch Hat Builder Punch (159856), Baker's Twine Essentials Pack (155475), Wink of Stella (141897), Stampin' Seal+ (149699), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (119755), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Black Tulle & 1/8" Hole Punch (non-Stampin' Up)



### Cutting & Scoring:

- Basic White - scraps
- Pumpkin Pie - scraps
- Gingham Cottage DSP – 5 1/4" x 4 1/2"

### Instructions for Treat/Gift Card. Holder:

- Die cut Gingham Cottage DSP using Mini Pocket Envelope Die.
- Fold on score lines and adhere together.
- Stamp witch feet on scrap white cardstock, and fussy cut.
- Color witch socks using Dark Pumpkin Pie Blend and boot buckle using Mango Medley Stampin' Write Marker.
- Add Wink of Stella to buckle.
- Punch a 2 black witch hats and add adhesive along bottom brim of witch hat on both pieces (be sure you put the adhesive on the correct SIDE of the hat – when finished they will be adhered together, so wrong sides together).
- Place about a 1" wide piece of black tulle along the edge, gathering it as you adhere it.
- Once it's completed add the top witch hat to secure the black tulle in between
- Trim had down white a bit from the top and adhere on the inside front of Mini Pocket Envelope
- Stamp spider and sentiment in Memento Black ink on scrap Pumpkin Pie cardstock.
- Die cut using stitched oval in Mini Pocket Envelope Die set.
- Punch a 1/8" hole at the top of this tag.

- Wrap Black Baker's Twine around envelope twice and tie in to bow on front side – be sure to include your orange oval tag as you tie your bow.
- Add candy!
