- STAMPS Winterly Tree Tops Bundle (164066)
- PAPER Cherry Cobbler CS (119685), Basic White CS (159276), Balmy Blue CS (146982)
- INK Tuxedo Black Memento Ink (132708), Versamark Pad(102283), Balmy Blue Stampin' Blends (154830), Cherry Cobbler Stampin' Blends (154880), Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends (154883), Crumb Cake Stamping' Blends (154882)
- OTHER Snowflake Sky 3D Embossing Folder (162026), Wink of Stella (141897), Wow! Embossing Powder Basics (165679), Heat Tool (129053), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Cherry Cobbler CS- 11" x 4-1/4" card base score & fold at 5-1/2", 3/4" x 2-3/4"
- Basic White CS- 4" x 5-1/4", 2-3/4" x 3-3-3/4"
- Balmy Blue CS 3-3/4" x 5"

Instructions:

- Emboss the 4" x 5-1/4" Basic White CS with the Snowflake Sky 3D Embossing folder.
- Adhere the embossed Basic White CS to the Cherry Cobbler card base.
- Cut the Balmy Blue CS with the foliage frame die from the Winterly Tree Tops dies.
- Stamp the birds with Tuxedo Black Memento ink on the 2-3/4" x 3-3/4" Basic White CS.
- Color the birds with Stampin' Blends.
- Die cut the birds using the Winterly Tree Tops dies.
- Stamp the sentiment on Cherry Cobbler CS 3/4" x 2-3/4"in Versamark ink.
- Cover the sentiment with the white embossing powder and shake off the excess.
- Heat the sentiment with the Heat Tool.

- Position the birds and the sentiment on the frame and attach them to the frame with Mini Glue • Dots.
- Adhere the frame, birds, and sentiment to the Basic White layer with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Apply Wink of Stella to the berries.

- OTHER Natural Tones Linen Thread (164071), Pétal Pink & White 1/4" Diagonal Trim Combo Pack (163417), Wink of Stella (141897), Wow! Embossing Powder Basics (165679), Heat Tool (129053), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Min Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), hole punch

## Cutting & Scoring:

- Balmy Blue CS 5-1/4" x 8" scored at 2-1/4" x 6"
- Cherry Cobbler CS 3-1/2" x 4-1/2", 3/4" x 2-1/2"
- Garden Green CS 2" x 3-1/2"
- Basic White CS 2-3/4" x 3-3-3/4"(birds), 1-1/2" x 5" (berries)
- Nests of Winter DSP 3-1/4" x 4-1/4"

## Instructions:

- Stamp the birds with Tuxedo Black Memento ink on Basic White CS.
- Color the birds with the Stampin' Blends.
- Die cut the birds with the Winterly Tree Tops dies.
- Stamp the sentiment with Versamark ink on Cherry Cobbler CS (3/4" x 2-1/2")
- Cover the sentiment with the white embossing powder and shake off the excess.
- Heat the sentiment with the Heat Tool.

- Die cut 4 Green Green leaves with the Winterly Tree Tops dies.
- Use the stamp with the 2 birds and ink the berries only (berry clump closest to the bird) with Tuxedo Black Memento ink on Basic White CS. Repeat 2 more times.
- Fussy cut or use the coordinating die to cut out the berries. The berries will require some fussy cutting even when using the dies.
- Adhere the DSP to the Cherry Cobbler CS.
- Adhere the birds to the DSP.
- Adhere the sentiment.
- Adhere the Garden Green leaves in the corners.
- Use Mini Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the berries over the leaves.
- Tie 2 small Garden Green Linen Thread bows. Use Multipurpose Liquid Glue to attach them to the berries stem.
- Fold the Balmy Blue CS along the score lines and use adhesive along the overlap to close.
- Use a hole punch and punch through both layers of cardstock.
- Thread the white 1/4" Diagonal Trim Combo Pack through both holes.
- Place the seed packet on the ribbon and push down until the seed packet is no longer visible. Tie a bow. The bow will be used to pull the packet up and down.
- The extra berry bunch can be used to cover up the price of the seed packet or add it for decoration.
