Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS Regal Flora (164157) or Bundle with the Regal Flora Dies & save 10% (164034) from the 2024 Sept-Dec Mini Catalog
- PAPER Blackberry Bliss (133675), Basic White (159276), Boho Blue (161724), Regal Winter 12" x 12" Designer Series Paper (164156)
- INK Night of Navy (147110)
- OTHER Regal Flora Dies (164033), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Blackberry Bliss & Gold 1/2" Textured Ribbon, Regal Foiled Adhesive Backed Dots (164038), Take Your Pick Tool (144107), Stampin' Seal (152813), Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue (110755), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Blackberry Bliss Cardstock 4-1/4" x 11" card base, score & fold at 5-1/2"; scrap for die-cut shape
- Boho Blue scrap for die-cut shape
- Basic White 4" \dot{X} 5-1/4"; 3/8" x 1-1/2" for the sentiment
- Regal Winter DSP Navy Floral Pattern: 3-7/8" x 5-1/8"; Multicolor Floral Pattern scrap for overlay

Instructions:

- Die-cut the Multicolor Floral Pattern scrap with the Floral Border Die. Die-cut two sets of shapes using the Blackberry Bliss and the Boho Blue scraps.
- Adhere the panel of Basic White to the card base followed by the Navy Floral DSP. Use Multi-purpose
 Liquid Glue to attach the Blackberry Bliss outline shape to the card base as shown, but don't press too
 hard on the right side as to allow the Boho Blue shape to be placed beneath the Blackberry Bliss outline
 shape as shown.
- Adhere a 4-1/4" angle-cut piece of Blackberry Bliss & Gold Textured Ribbon flush with the bottom of the Boho Blue die-cut with Stampin' Seal. Use Multi-purpose Liquid Glue to adhere the Multicolor Floral Border Die-cut to the ribbon and Boho Blue panel.
- Stamp the sentiment onto the Basic White sentiment panel. Adhere as shown with Mini Dimensional. Use the Take Your Pick Tool to scatter three Regal Foiled Dots onto the card as shown.

- OTHER Book Treat Boxes (164048), Regal Flora Dies (164033), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Blackberry Bliss & Gold 1/2" Textured Ribbon, Regal Foiled Adhesive Backed Dots (164038), Take Your Pick Tool (144107), Stampin' Seal (152813), Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue (110755), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Blackberry Bliss Cardstock 4-1/4" x 7-1/4" scored at 3-1/8" and 4-1/8"; 1-1/16" x 3"
- Basic White Cardstock 2-3/4" x 3-7/8"; scrap for sentiment
- Boho Blue scrap for die-cut
- Regal Winter DSP Navy Floral Pattern 2-5/8" x 3-3/4"

Instructions:

- Adhere the Navy Floral pattern to the Basic White. Use the scrap of Boho Blue to die-cut the outline shape and secure to the DSP as shown with Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue.
- Stamp the sentiments and fussy cut the words. Use Mini Dimensionals to secure them to the front panel as shown. Use the Take Your Pick Tool to scatter three of the Regal Foiled Dots as desired. Set aside the completed panel.
- Assemble the Book Treat Box. Attach the smaller Blackberry Bliss panel to the back of the closure tab
 and the back of the box with Multi-Purpose Liquid Glue, folding it where the score line is, as well as along
 the back of the box. Use a scissors to round the corners of the Blackberry Bliss to match the rounded
 corners of the tab piece. Do not remove the adhesive on the tab to close it. It will stay closed with the
 ribbon tie-on as well as being tucked under the front panel.
- Secure the scored panel of Blackberry Bliss to the Book Treat Box, lining up the score lines. Fill the box with treats or a gift card. Then, tie on 18" of the Blackberry Bliss & Gold ribbon, making a bow and trimming the edges at an angle.
- Triple layer Dimensionals in each corner of the completed front panel. Center and set over the front of the Book Treat Box.
